Both online MSW Traditional and Advanced Standing programs are a combination of fully online and live online courses, so you can earn your degree remotely. We are committed to equipping students to advocate for the population and communities they are most passionate about serving.

PROGRAM FORMAT

Online Traditional MSW:

- 60 credit hours
- Finish in 8 semesters

Online Advanced Standing MSW:

- 35 credit hours
- Finish in as few as 3 semesters full time or 5 semesters part time

Online Advanced Standing MSW*:

Must hold a Bachelor's Degree in social work from a regionally accredited institution* and satisfy the following criteria:

- Minimum "B-" in the social work courses and minimum overall 3.0 GPA The GRE is not required for admission.

The Online Advanced Standing MSW program requires that all applicants have a BSW degree from a Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) regionally accredited institution with a 3.0 cumulative GPA or a B average or better in all work attempted while registered as an undergraduate student working toward a bachelor's degree.
