Dr. Elias Stefanakos is Professor of Electrical Engineering and Director of the Clean Energy Research Center (CERC) at the University of South Florida (USF) in Tampa, Florida. Up to August 2003 and for 13 years he was Chairman of the Department of Electrical Engineering at USF. He is Editor in Chief of the Journal of Power and Energy Engineering (JPEE) and Associate Editor (PV) of the Journal of Solar Energy. He has a number of patents and published over 200 research papers in refereed journals and international conferences in the areas of smart materials, solar energy production and storage, hydrogen storage, etc. He has received contracts and grants from agencies such as, the National Science Foundation (NSF), US Department of Energy (USDOE, ARPAe), NASA, and other. CERC is an interdisciplinary center whose mission is the development of new clean energy systems and energy storage, with emphasis on technology development and technology transfer.
