

CHEMICAL HAZARD

Agent: Streptozotocin

Laboratory Hazard: Potential human health hazard. May cause eye, skin, and respiratory and digestive tract irritation. May cause liver and kidney damage. May cause adverse reproductive effects. Causes cancer in animals. Cancers hours post-administration of the agent to animals, during husbandry, and during the

Precautions: Limited access. Agent may be excreted up to 72 hours post-administration, and precautions should be taken to avoid contact with animal body fluids and caging/bedding aerosols/dust during this time. A disposable gown, double latex/chemical resistant gloves, and a respirator should be worn during handling.
