Whether you are sick or injured, managing a chronic health problem, or working to develop a healthier lifestyle, Student Health Services (SHS) is here to help. The services provided by SHS, in collaboration with the other USF departments, can help you achieve and maintain this healthy lifestyle, and thereby support your academic success.



WHAT SERVICES DOES SHS OFFER?

Student Health Services offers services ranging from primary care for illness or injury to mental health and wellness professionals such as a clinical psychologists, from nutritional counseling to sexual health and testing/immunizations. SHS accepts many different insurance plans and can even help you set up medical insurance if you are currently without it.



WHAT ARE USF'S IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS?

You can log into your student account on OASIS to see what your immunization status is and the specific requirements for your student type. Every student will need to fill out a **Medical History Immunization Form**, found on Student Health Services website, and submit it to SHS prior to taking classes at the university. Failure to submit these documents or take the appropriate immunizations will result in a delay when registering for courses and **put a hold on your account**.



HOW DO I MAKE AN APPOINTMENT?

Depending on the service you are requesting, you may be able to do a walk-in appointment. Some services will, however, require an appointment. You can do so by phone or you can walk into the clinic and schedule an appointment in person.
