The following is additional information for the Social Science Education major:

- The College of Education (COEDU) has a SEPARATE APPLICATION PROCESS from that of the University of South Florida. Please allow enough time to apply and receive acceptance to USF before applying to the College.
- The Social Science Education program admits all three terms (fall, spring, summer).
- It is highly recommended that applicants to the COEDU (except Exercise Science) satisfy all sections of the General Knowledge Test, including Math, Reading, Language, and Essay before their first term in the college.
- All applicants must have an overall GPA of 2.5.
- EDF 1005 must be completed with a C- or better or in progress at the time of application.
- Florida Teacher Certification Exams (General Knowledge Test, Professional Education, and Subject Area Exams) are required for graduation as the degree prepares students to earn a Florida Teaching Certificate.
- The Social Science Education program is a joint program between the College of Education and the College of Arts and Sciences. The program engages students in the study of cultural and historical tradition and informed social criticism. The program integrates methods of inquiry and pedagogy with an interdisciplinary including coursework in psychology, economics, anthropology, sociology, political science, and other fields of study.
